

KCC Youth Promote the Green Gospel

In March, the church's Youth Group will begin encouraging our congregation to walk, skate, carpool, or bike to the church on Sunday mornings. Stickers designed by the young people will be available in the narthex for those who do something "green," whether it is recycling a bulletin, bringing a reusable coffee mug or avoiding fossil fuels to get to church. The youth will also request donations and sell fair trade products to fund a permanent bike rack for KCC.



The Youth Group spent much of the Fall studying green initiatives, topped off by a weekend eco-logic retreat at Camp Stevens in Julian. The bike rack and green gospel projects are the culmination of this work.

On Feb. 12, the youth, together with guest speaker and Eco-Best Practices manager, AnnD Canavan, discussed ways the church can promote sustainability and the preservation of Mother Earth. The ideas will be presented to the church trustees in hope that we can change a few of our habits and waste less of the earth's precious resources.
